Session I (10.30-12.00)



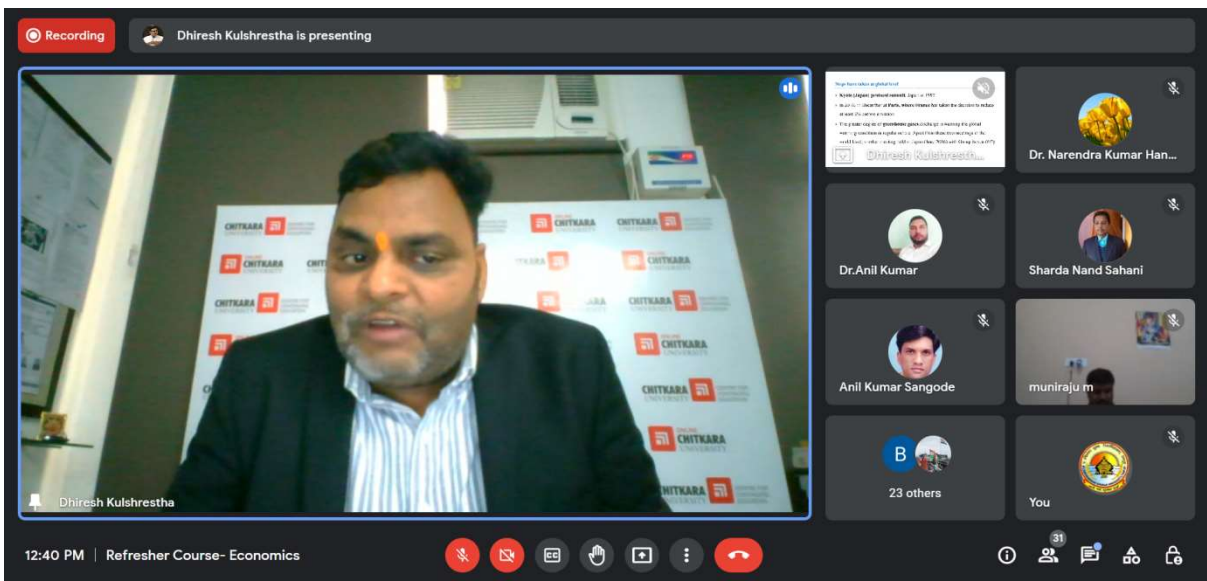

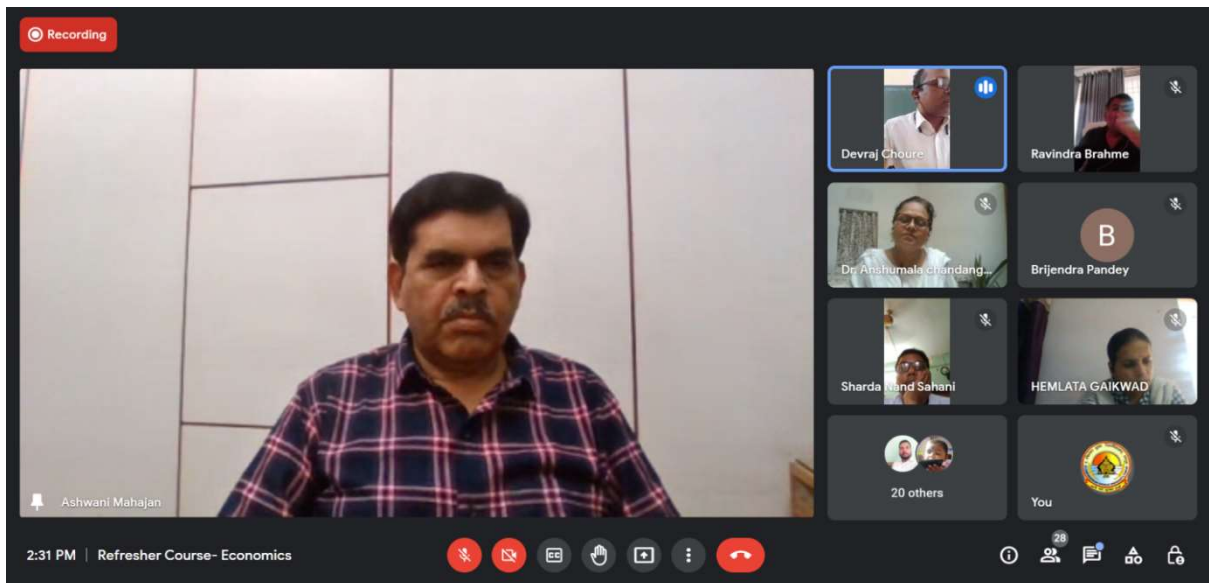

Session I (10.30-12.00)

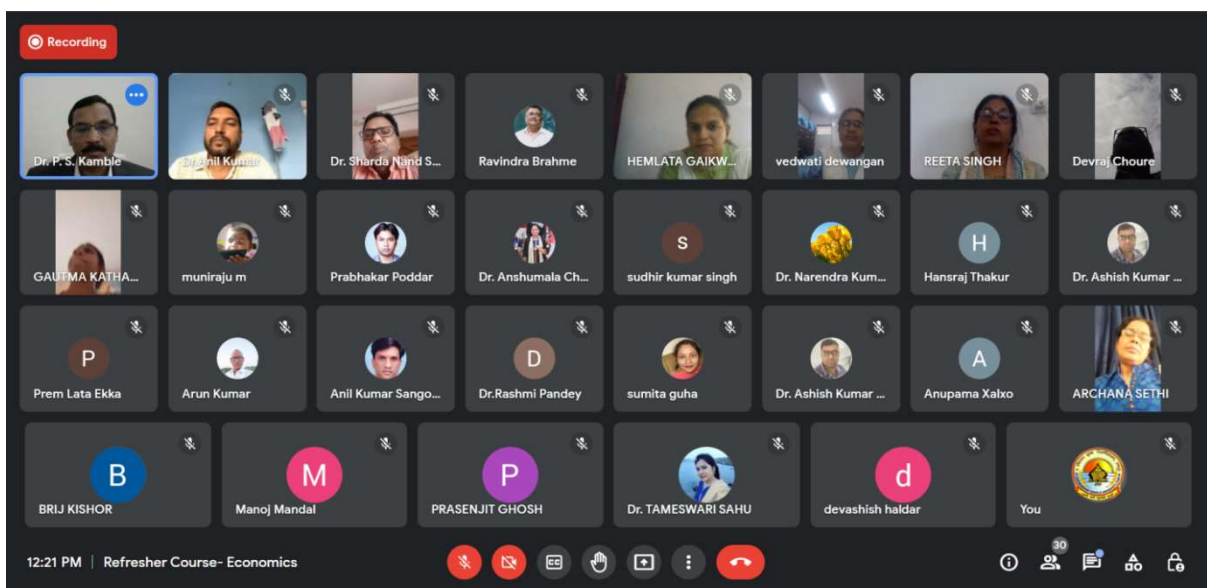

is a new concept of sea resources where the Sea sources are targeted and also the resources in moon and other planets are searched for fulfilling our needs.

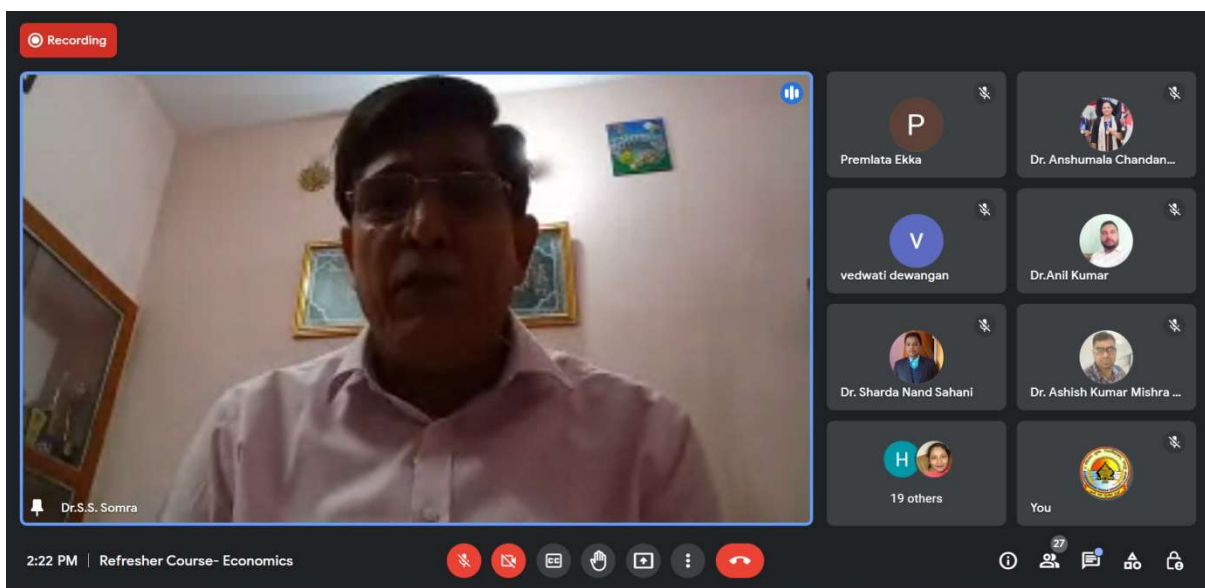

the way human treats there environment human treat their environment will have an impact of the quality of human.

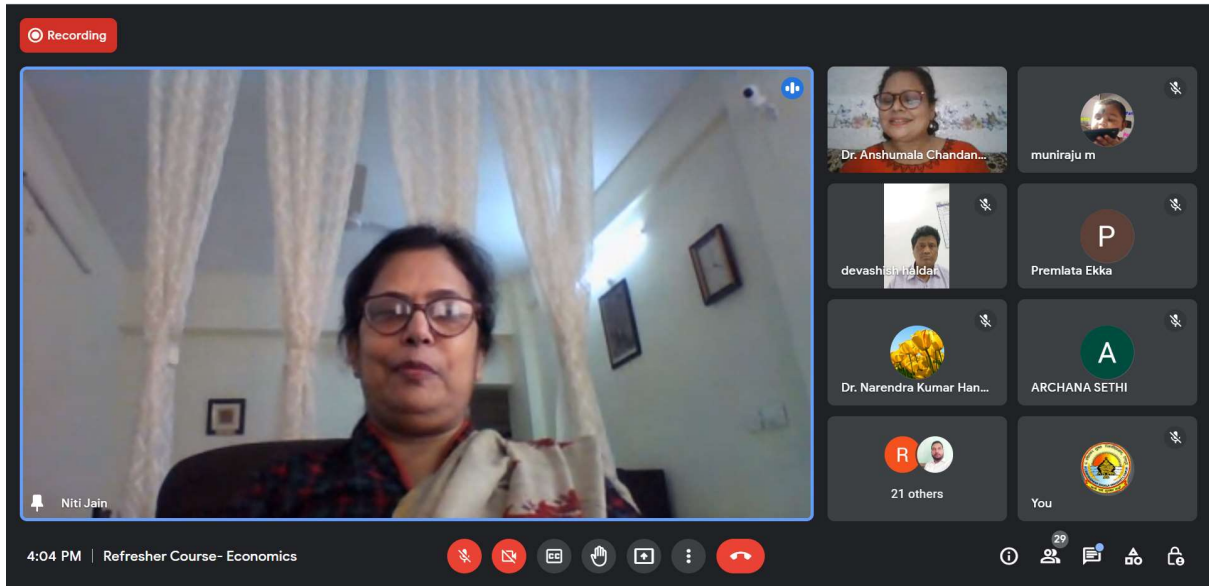

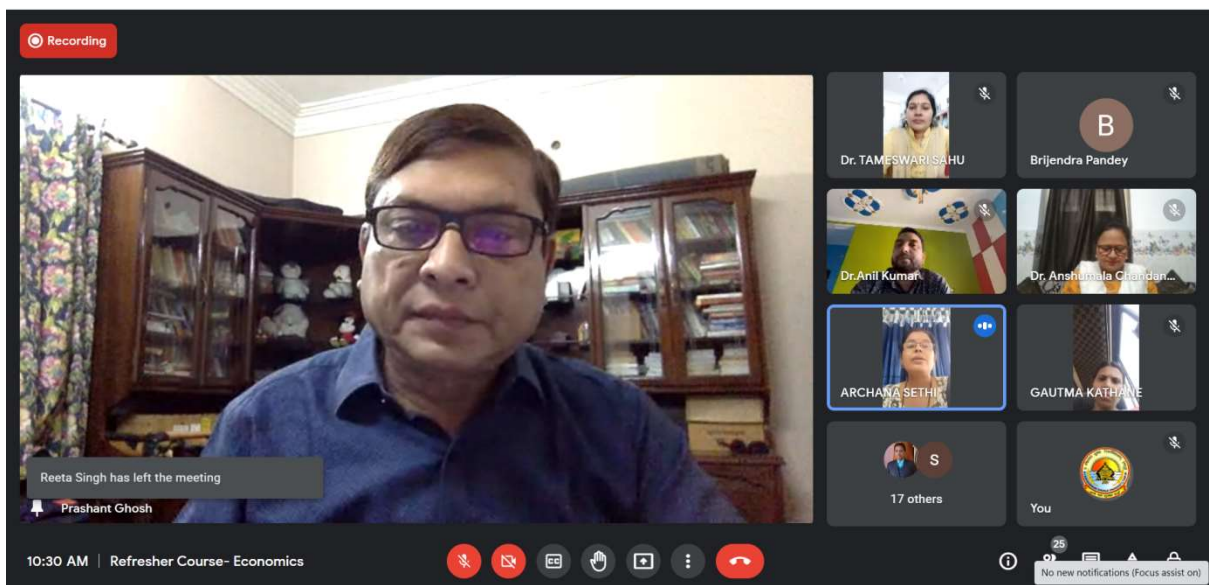

the chlorofluorocarbon problem has to be sorted out.


